

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


## The Practical Color Wheel




### Instructions:



















# The Tints, Tones, Shades, and Shadows of Colors

**Comprehending Color Variations** 




### Creating tints, tones, and shade


**Tint** exists by adding white to a base color, lighting the hue and resulting in a lighter version of that color.


**Tone** lives as a result of adding gray (a mixture of black and white) to a base color.

**Shade** by explanation shade exists by adding black to a base color, resulting in a darker version of that original hue.
